2       the enactment of this Act and compare such amount  
3       to the estimated amount of Federal spending during  
4       such period.

5       (b) REDUCTION IN SPENDING.—In any year in which  
6       the Secretary reports under subsection (a)(2) that the  
7       amount of Federal spending expected in the 10-year pe-  
8       riod that begins on the date that the report is submitted  
9       under subsection (a)(2) exceeds the amount of estimated  
10      revenue generated pursuant to provisions of this Act for  
11      that same 10-year period, the Secretary shall reduce Fed-  
12      eral spending under this Act so that such spending does  
13      not exceed such revenue.

14      (c) DETERMINATION OF ESTIMATED SPENDING  
15      AMOUNT IN INITIAL PERIOD.—

16           (1) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of this section,  
17      the score issued by the Director of the Congressional  
18      Budget Office for the enrolled version of the bill that  
19      became this Act for the 10-year period following the  
20      date such score is issued shall be used as the esti-  
21      mated amount of spending for the initial period.

22           (2) CONTINGENCY PROCESS.—

23           (A) IN GENERAL.—If no such score is  
24      issued, not later than 30 days after the date of  
25      the enactment of this Act, the Director of the

1 Congressional Budget Office shall submit to the  
2 President and the Congress a report that con-  
3 tains a determination of the amount of spend-  
4 ing that is expected during the initial period as  
5 a result of this Act.

6 (B) USE OF AMOUNT.— The amount de-  
7 termined under subparagraph (A) shall be used  
8 as the estimated amount of spending for the  
9 initial period for purposes of this section.
